

**Election
protocol**

**of the elections for the 50th Student
Parliament and the Student Councils of the
University of Siegen from 12.06. - 16.06.2023**

Preliminary remark

The election committee for the election of the 50th student parliament, henceforth called StuPa election, and the student council election, henceforth called FSR election, consisted of the following persons:

With the expiry of the contestation period of this election protocol, the election committee ends its activity and wishes the new StuPa as well as the members of the FSRe much success in their work.

Work of the Election Committee

The constituent meeting took place on 31.10.2022, introduced by the StuPa presidium, in persona Jenny Lamb. Céline Lea Erhardt was elected as election chair and Carmen Richter as deputy chair via Zoom. The latter, however, was only elected until her retirement in February, after which Moritz Rossmann, who had already held this position the previous year, was elected as deputy election director.

After internal consultation and a discussion in the StuPa, an election newspaper was produced this year that could only be viewed online. This decision was made for reasons of sustainability. However, it was offered to print the election newspaper as well, but only on request. Five copies were printed and made available to the public in the AStA, AStA Shop, Autonomous Cultural Department, Café Chaos and in the sofa room of the mathematics and physics student councils.

The election committee, since the university administration had not approved this, did not set up any rules on billposting, but pointed out that this was not allowed in university buildings. Nevertheless, posters were put up, especially in the AR-D, even within sight of the election booths. These were taken down by the election committee. The Juso HSG and ★ZAK were reprimanded for this.

The little campaigning that was done by the lists was, with a few exceptions, done in a fair manner. The International List was formally reprimanded for violating this and distributing flyers in a lecture hall, near the voting booth and in visibility. The reprimand of the Juso HSG was reinforced by the fact that they had left their flyers in AR-M (LEO) in view of the election booth. These were removed by the Election Committee. Another incident, in which a person standing for election tore down posters from other lists, was reported anonymously, via the submission of a video, and is being clarified at the legal office.

This year, the electoral committee decided on a voters' register via the internal university platform Sciebo. It was possible for everyone to access and update it directly via their mobile device. This happened without any major technical or organisational errors or disruptions. It was necessary for everyone to be able to access it as easily as possible, as it was not possible for the election committee to organise enough laptops for all locations, also due to the fact that the ZIMT was no longer available as a lending point.

Conduct of the elections

The election notice was posted in due time on 12.05.2023 and made available online. All deadlines were set on the basis of the election regulations and can be found in the election notice.

In the StuPa meeting of 09.05.2023, the election committee recommended that the allowance for election workers be set at 20€ for a two-hour shift. Throughout the week, voting was possible at the AR-HB, AR-D, AR-M, H, PB-D, US-C and ENC-D campuses from 10am to 3pm. There were some delays due to buses or other reasons, but this could always be compensated for by the election workers present. Only twice did election workers drop out so spontaneously that a member of the election committee had to take over the shift.

All election workers were briefed on site and in advance via a document. There were no problems with this.

The ballot boxes and voting booths were provided by the university administration. The ballot boxes were checked and sealed by the election committee before voting began.

All voting booths were set up and dismantled daily by the election committee. The ballot boxes and ballot papers were stored in the university administration. On the first day, during the third shift, between 2:30 and 3:00 p.m., the electoral roll on Sciebo could not be updated because someone had frozen the image section. This was promptly fixed by the electoral committee. Furthermore, a backup copy of the previous electoral roll was made every day.

Since the university administration had extended the re-registration deadline unplanned, there were about 10 people who were not listed in the electoral roll. Since there was no option to postpone the election, they had thought about this in advance and, together with a current certificate of study, it was still possible for these people to vote. We would like to point out that we were only informed of this by the university administration when the electoral roll was sent to us.

As there were no ballot papers for the FSRes GHR at the beginning of the week, it was only possible to vote for them at some locations from around 11:00 a.m., as they still had to be printed.

During the week, ballot papers for the FSRes Physics, Mathematics, WIR, Social Work, GHR, GG LaBaMa, Psychology and also ballot papers for the StuPa election had to be reprinted. This was mostly done within an hour. For the next election committee, we took the trouble to record internally which FSR was elected at which location in order to reduce this next year. We were also unable to get the same shade of blue for the FSR GHR, which is why these ballot papers were a different shade of dark blue from halfway through the week.

Two persons were not listed on the ballot papers and one person was misspelled. This had already been noted in advance and changed on the lists that were handed out, but not on the ballot papers that were also drawn up at the beginning. It has been clarified with both persons and their respective student councils how they can still participate.

Due to the small number of postal ballots, they were mixed with the ballots from the ENC-D ballot boxes in order to avoid drawing conclusions about the voters.

An error occurred during the count, as it was assumed that ballot papers with less than three votes cast were to be declared invalid. This was not the case and as a result the counting had to be done again on the same evening.

The provisional election result was also incorrect, as the votes of the AR-M were not embedded in the Excel spreadsheet for the election result, according to Saint Laguë. The actual election results were published directly after the determination by the Election Committee.

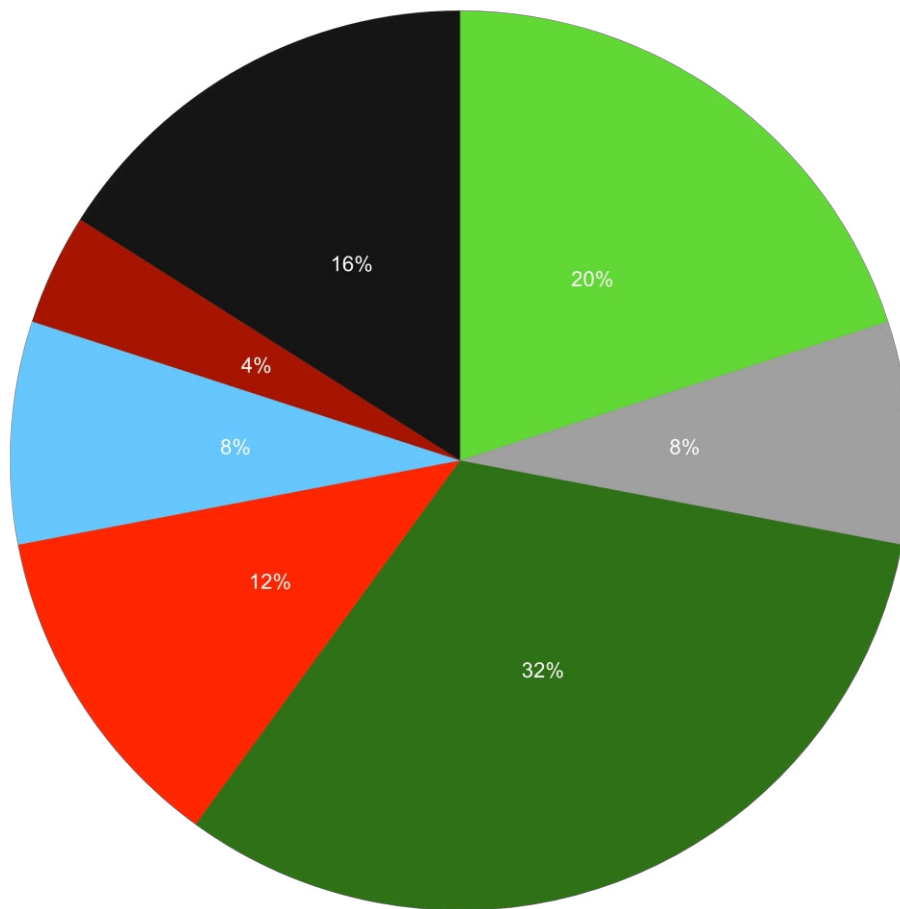

Recommendations

- Clarify regulations for billposting at an early stage
- Expand regulations and suggestions for other election campaigns and perhaps organise something like a market of possibilities for lists
- Define more precisely the number of votes in the case of abstention and define more precisely when a ballot paper is not valid, e.g. in the electoral regulations.
- Expand advertising for elections
- Make election booths more visible
- Limit the number of people at the count. Suggestion would be approx. 30 people
- Write down explanations in English and German, separately and in a more differentiated way, especially for the count
- Better editing and editorial revision of formal documents
- More pens and coloured pens for the count
- Better integrate other initiatives
- Work mobile phone for election workers Contact person
